'So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.' Isaiah 55:11

'For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.' Hebrews 4:12

'Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.' Proverbs 18:21

The Lord has stated that His word will not return to Him void but will accomplish what He pleases. God's word is alive and active, which means it can move and impact your spirit, soul and body. But if you do not read it, you will not know what is available to you. Beyond reading, you must also speak the word to transform and make an impact in your life.

When we speak God's word, we shape lives, environments or destinies. So it's important to know what to say and when. In this study we will look at some of the transformational declarations we should be speaking into our lives.

Day 1

Victory

God arms me with strength, and he makes my way perfect. He makes me as surefooted as a deer, enabling me to stand on mountain heights. He trains my hands for battle; he strengthens my arm to draw a bronze bow. You have given me your shield of victory. Your right hand supports me; your help has made me great. You have made a wide path for my feet to keep them from slipping." Psalms 18:32-36

When we try and win in our own strength we shortchange ourselves. Our God who is omnipotent, omniscient and omnipresent is infinitely more able to give us victory better than we could ever do in more ways than we have the capacity to conceive of. Today we are declaring our victory comes from God and He alone.

Declaration: The Lord has armed me with strength so I will not falter, faint or fail. The Lord makes my way perfect therefore the lines fall for me in perfect places. Because I yield to the Holy Spirit, my life is in alignment with His plans for my life. I have the strength to face any challenge without fear or confusion because the Lord Himself trains my hands and gives me the strategies for success. Impossible situations are possible for me because the Lord enables me to break bows of bronze. My confidence is in the Lord because in Him and Him alone I have victory. The Lord upholds me and holds me up by His mighty right hand. He alters situations around me so I am not confined by any circumstance or limitations. I am victorious in the Lord.

Day 2

Blessings

Each day is a blank page waiting for you to write the script for it to follow. If you do not speak into your day, you leave yourself open for other factors to decide how your day will go. And that would not be a wise decision. Rather you should search the aspect of God's word you want to see in your day and shape your day in advance with it. Today we are declaring blessings into the day using Deuteronomy 28:1-14 as our anchor scripture.

Declaration: Lord I ask for the grace to diligently obey your voice that I may carefully observe all the Holy Spirit says to me this season. I declare Lord that today is blessed by you from the rising of the sun to the setting thereof. I declare that today Lord all your blessings shall come upon me and overtake me. I am blessed wherever I go. My children are blessed, the works of my hands are blessed. Today brings me increase in all I put my hands to. All I touch today is blessed and brings fruitfulness and multiplication. All my work tools are blessed, my place of work is blessed, my business is blessed. I am blessed when I come in and blessed when I go out. The Lord will cause my enemies who rise against me to be defeated before me. They may come out against me in one way, but the Lord will make them flee before me seven ways.

The Lord will command the blessing on me in my storehouses, in all to which I set my hand, and He will bless me in the land I occupy. The Lord will grant me plenty of goods, in the fruit of my body, in the increase of my business/career.

The Lord will open to me His good treasure, the dew of heaven will fall upon me, to give the rain to my land in its season, and to bless all the work of my hand. I will lend to many nations, but I shall not borrow. The Lord will make me the head and not the tail; I shall be above only, and not be beneath. With God by my side I shall not turn to the right or the left to go after other gods to serve them, but I shall fix my eyes and heart on Jesus, the author and finisher of my faith.

Day 3

Divine Security

We live in a time where there's no security guaranteed in any geographical location. From wars to viruses to fires and other environmental, economic and political issues, practically every country seems to be dealing with one issue or the other. So where can we go for help? Where can we be safe? The Bible lets us know that true security is not located in any person or place, but in the King of Kings alone. That's why today we will declare our reliance on Him using Psalms 91 and 121 as our anchor scriptures.

Declaration: My help comes from the Lord who made the heavens and the earth. He will take care of me, so that I do not fall. The Lord who keeps me safe will not sleep. Yes! The Lord never gets tired or sleeps at all! The Lord is close beside me to give me shade from the hot sun. The hot sun will not hurt me in the daytime. At night, the moon cannot hurt me. The Lord takes care of me in all danger, He keeps my life safe. Whatever I do and wherever I go, the Lord will always keep me safe, now and forever.

As I stay in the secret place of the Most High God I remain under the shadow of the Almighty. I declare that you Lord are the strong place where I am safe. You are my God and I am trusting in you. Your word says Lord that you will save me from the traps that are hidden. You will save me from illnesses that cause death. You cover me you're your feathers, I am safe under your wings. You are a faithful God and will do what you promised. Lord you are a shield over me so I will not be afraid of bad spirits at night, or the arrow that flies in the day, or illnesses that come when it is dark, or something bad that may destroy at midday. A thousand people may die by my side, and ten thousand people by my right hand. But the danger will not come near to me. My eyes will see it and watch, while it destroys bad people. For you Lord make me safe.

Because the Most High is my home, bad things will not happen to me or anyone in my care. And there will be no evil near where I live. For you Lord will tell Your angels what to do for me. They will make me safe everywhere that I go. Their hands will give me help so that I will not even hurt my feet on a stone. I will walk on the lion and the cobra. The young lion and the serpent will be under my feet. Lord, You said You will make the person safe that loves You. Danger will not hurt me because I know and trust in Your name. Father, when I pray, You will answer me. You have promised Lord that I have trouble, You will be with me. You will save me and satisfy me with a long life.

Day 4 Favour

Our Father in heaven is a good God, He is mindful of those that are His and has designed a system called favour to assist His children move smoothly through life. When God gives you favour, it does not matter how people feel about you, they will be compelled to act in your best interest. God uses favour as a tool to enable us fulfil our God given assignments as well as aid our peace of mind. Today we will speak favour into our day using Daniel 1:9,20; Psalm 5:12; Esther 2:15, Psalms 84:11; 90:17; Proverbs 3:3-4 as our anchor scriptures.

Declaration: Lord God Your favour Lord lasts a lifetime, You are a sun and shield to those that are yours. You give grace and glory and no good thing will You withhold from those who walk uprightly. Lord I declare that today I walk in your favour and goodwill surrounds me today. You guide me continually, you satisfy my soul in drought and strengthen my bones. You water me like a garden and I am like a spring of waters whose waters do not fail. You surround me with your favour as with a shield and I obtain favour in the sight of all who see me.

I declare that today I increase in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men. I declare that the favour of the Lord our God is upon me and establishes the work of my hands for me. The Lord is the glory of my strength, and in His favor my horn is exalted. Today I smell like a field the Lord has blessed and the scent of my favour spreads across the nations. Today I obtain favour from kings, those who do not know me and even those who do not like me will assist me to accomplish the Lord's purposes for my life.



Day 5 Sight

The ability to see is integral to our functioning effectively in life. Sight enables us to see what's around us and assists us to make accurate decisions in navigating. But seeing isn't limited to our natural sight alone, we also need sight to navigate the spiritually as well. In Mark 10:46-52 we read the story of blind Bartimaeus. The interesting thing is that even though the man was blind in the natural, he recognized that the opportunity had come for his healing.

The Bible tells us we are in an age where darkness covers not just the environment but the people as well (Isa 60:2). Accuracy of sight becomes all the more important when there's darkness as it's easy to misinterpret what's happening around you. You may not only miss opportunities that are right in front of you, but you also run the risk of taking wrong steps. As always the Lord doesn't leave us stranded, He's given us an opportunity to receive true sight so we make the right decisions and perform optimally. Our anchor scriptures are Psalm 119:37, Revelation 3:18, 2 Kings 6:17.

Declaration: Though darkness covers the earth and deep darkness the people; my Lord arises over me and His glory will be seen upon me. Lord Jesus you open my eyes and turn my eyes away from worthless things. You anoint my eyes to see what is really important and you preserve my life according to your word. I see the doors of opportunity you have opened for me. I see the traps and distractions the enemy has set before me and I navigate accurately by your grace. I see what lies ahead and I plan strategically by your grace. I see clearly what may have gone wrong in the past and I take the right corrective steps. I walk in complete clarity and accuracy full of confidence in you because you have said you will never leave me nor forsake me and you will lead me along the best pathway for my life. I walk without fear because I see that there are always more for me than there are against me. My eyes are open Lord and they remain focused on you and you alone in the name of Jesus.

Day 6 Deliverance

For some reason, there's a general misconception that believers won't face challenges in life. But Jesus Himself tells us in John 16:33 that we will have many issues in this world. However, we shouldn't be overwhelmed by our troubles because He has overcome the world. In Jesus we have an assurance of deliverance from the trials that we may face. The deliverance could be in the form of an eradication of the issue it could be the provision of supernatural peace in the middle of it all. Today we're declaring our deliverance from every trial and tribulation using Psalms 34, 37:40, 2 Corinthians 1:8-10, Isaiah 54:17 as our anchor scriptures

Declaration: Lord Jesus you have destroyed the works of the devil and have overcome the world. Today I declare that I do not trust in myself but in God who delivers me from every trial. Your word says it doesn't matter how many things may afflict me because you deliver me from them All! You Lord are my help and deliverer. You will deliver me from the wicked and save me because I put my trust in You alone. I will not be overwhelmed by troubles. I will arise and shine because my light has come, and the Lord has shown me a way of deliverance out of every tribulation.

I declare that no weapon formed against me shall prosper and every tongue which rises against me in judgment I condemn because this my heritage. I am delivered from every danger known and unknown, seen and unseen. I walk in divine health, power and soundness of mind. Your word says Lord that your angel encamps all around those who fear you and deliver them. Jehovah you alone will I trust, you alone will I reverence, and I receive your deliverance. I receive grace to stand firm in the midst of the challenges and to find rest in you. Make haste to deliver me Lord. Deliver me according your word.

Day 7 Praise

The Bible tells us that God inhabits the praise of His people and when God shows up things can never remain the same. In Psalm 22 we see how David was going through some very serious issues and yet at each point he paused to proclaim praises to God. Why would someone going through such issues focus on praising God? David understood something: when you praise you shift your attention from the size of your problems to the capacity of your God, the maker of the heavens and the earth. When you do that, you transfer the issues from your shoulders to His ever-capable hands. There is power in praising God! Things happen inside and around us when we praise with an open heart. Today, make the choice not to be consumed by the issues and stresses of life. Choose to ask God to help you focus on the One who can turn things around for your good. Today we will declare our praises to God using Psalm 22, 34 and 150 as our anchor scripture.

Declaration: Praise the Lord! I will praise the Lord at all times, I will constantly speak his praises. I will boast only in the Lord, I will tell of His greatness and exalt His name. The Lord answers me and frees me from all my fears. I praise God in His sanctuary I praise Him in His mighty heaven! I praise Him for His mighty works, I praise His unequalled greatness! I praise him with song, with dance, with all that I have and all that I am. I praise you Lord because you are a great God, and a great King above all gods. I praise you and do not forget all your benefits. I praise you because you daily load me with benefits in the spirit. I praise because you forgive all my iniquity, you heal all my diseases, you redeem my life from the pit. You crown me with steadfast love and mercy. Bless the Lord oh my soul, let all that is within me bless His holy name. Today I set aside everything and bring my God a sacrifice of praise. Praise the Lord!

Day 8 Your Mind

The Bible states clearly, 'For as he thinks in his heart, so is he...' (Proverbs 23:7a). This means who you are is determined by what you think. Your mind is an incredibly powerful place. This is why the devil targets your mind first because that is the place where battles are fought and won or lost. It's from within your mind you begin to chart the path of your destiny. Your mind determines what you will or will not tolerate and what you will or will not permit to limit you. Paul tells us in Romans 12:2 that the transformation of our lives takes place in our mind. It's in our mind that we conform either to the world or to God's will.

What we think about consistently becomes what we focus on. what we focus on becomes what we put our energy into. What we put our energy into becomes what we see playing out in our lives. So, it all starts from the mind. With this understanding we will declare God's lordship over our minds using the following anchor scriptures: Philippians 2:5, Colossians 3:2, I Corinthians 2:16, Ephesians 4:23

Declaration: I declare that I have the mind of Christ Jesus. I think the way Jesus thinks, I reason the way He does. I assess every situation from the perspective of heaven and I respond accurately. I set my mind on things above, not on things on the earth. I recognize that I am a spiritual being and that the weapons of my warfare are not carnal but mighty through God to the breaking down of strongholds. I break out of every spiritual, mental, emotional, physical, financial stronghold. I have the mind of Christ so I walk in the understanding of the authority that I carry. I understand of who I am and whose I am. I walk in perfect peace because my mind is focused on the Lord alone. My hope and trust are in God alone and so I am not moved by any external circumstance, Jesus has already given me the victory I need.

My mind is renewed daily through God's word, so I remain fresh and flourishing. Because I have the mind of Christ I walk in love, I am strategic and innovative, I am creative, I have understanding, I walk in power, I am fruitful in every sphere of influence I occupy and I have soundness of mind. Nothing will trouble my mind or cast a shadow over my thoughts. My mind is filled with the illumination of God's light. I have the mind of Christ so I love God with all that I have and all that I am. I have the mind of Christ.

Day 9 Time

The greatest currency available to us on this side of eternity is time. Once a minute is gone, it's gone for good, it's not going to come back. The good thing is that when you use time well, you will reap the positive rewards. Likewise, when you don't you will pay the price for its misuse. The main reason we misuse time is because we often think we have more time available to do whatever we want and consequently we may procrastinate on important things and say to ourselves – I will do it tomorrow. But that's not how we're supposed to live. Ecclesiastes 3 tells us there's an appropriate time for everything, which means we're acting out of balance when we don't do the right thing at the right time.

In God's grand design, we are expected to be good stewards of all resources that have been made available to us and that includes time. Romans 14:12 tells us "...each of us will give a personal account to God." which means we will be expected to give the Lord an account of our time on this side of eternity. Given that the maximum number of years majority of people will live will be about 100 years, if you begin to look at the magnitude of all you could accomplish within this relatively short time frame, you will begin to realize that you really don't have the time to waste time. Our declaration today is anchored on Psalm 90:12

Declaration: I walk in the understanding of the importance of the gift of time. I acknowledge that I will be required to give a personal account to You Lord of what I did with the resources You gave me. So I do not look at what anyone else is doing. I focus on being productive and use every resource within my disposal efficiently. Holy Spirit, I submit today into your hands and receive your help to take charge of and be accountable for every hour, minute and second of my day. I receive divine clarity on what is really important and prioritize my days accordingly. I reduce the amount of time I spend on the things that don't really matter. I receive capacity and enablement to execute the things I am meant to and wisdom to recognize and say no to distractions. I acknowledge that my times are in your hands Lord and I yield to you. Lord I will not be ashamed on the day I give my account to you.

Day 10

Fruitfulness

The Lord gave us a command in Genesis 1:28 to be fruitful, multiply, and replenish the earth, subdue it and have dominion. Why? The answer is in Psalm 115:16 (TPT), "The heavens belong to our God; they are his alone, but he has given us the earth and put us in charge." The Lord expects us to be fruitful so we can be effective managers of the earth. Our fruitfulness in family, ministry, government, education, media, the marketplace and other areas establishes God's authority and demonstrates His character in these areas.

The Bible tells us in Matthew 5:13-14 we are the salt of the earth, which means we're to add a good flavour to our environment. Our lives are also supposed light up the world so others see our light from a distance. When we bear good fruit, we demonstrate tangible results which points people to the glory and superiority of the God we serve. Our declaration today is anchored on Psalm 92, Genesis 1:28, John 15:16 (AMP)

Declaration: All I have and am is yours Lord. You have blessed me and I bear an abundance of fruit, I multiply, I replenish, subdue and walk in dominion. I am an oak of righteousness planted for the display of the Lord's splendour. I am blessed and a blessing to everyone I am connected to and everywhere I am positioned. I excel in every good work. Because the Lord has chosen me, my fruitfulness does not diminish with time or age. As my years are so will my strength and fruitfulness be. I bear fruit in every season even in my old age I am fresh and flourishing. I am like a palm tree planted by rivers of living water. I walk in the knowledge of the will of God for my life so I live in a manner worthy of the Lord, bearing fruit in every good work. I bear fruit consistently and in greater measure every day of my life.

Day 11

Love

The Lord's primary motivation for doing anything with/in/for us is love. He loved us so much He gave Jesus to pay for our sins so we can be reconciled to Him. He also gave us the Holy Spirit to equip us to walk effectively and victoriously in life. As His children, we should also function the way our heavenly father functions – in love. Our primary motivation for doing anything that will be acceptable before God is love. Remember, people focus on the externals, but the Lord doesn't look at just the actions. Rather His focus is on the intent behind the actions.

Philippians 2:2b-4 puts it this way: '...agreeing wholeheartedly with each other, loving one another, and working together with one mind and purpose. Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves. Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too.' We are not supposed to be self-centered people who pull one another down – that mindset for those who don't have a relationship with God. And so we are clear on what God's definition of walking in love is, it's articulated clearly for us in our anchor scriptures 1 Corinthians 13:4-8, 14:1. As we make this declaration, also ask the Holy Spirit to help you make what you are declaring a reality in your everyday life.

Declaration: I am patient and kind. I am not jealous or boastful or proud or rude and I do not demand to have my own way, especially at the expense of others. I am not irritable, and I keep no record of being wronged. Whoever offends me I forgive quickly and freely without keeping malice, regardless of if I feel they deserve it or not. I do not rejoice when I come across injustice, but I rejoice whenever the truth wins out. I do not join others to walk in injustice. I never give up no matter how often I may be disappointed. I never lose faith, I keep my eyes fixed on Jesus and not what is around me or what people have done to me. I am always hopeful, I look for the best and am not quick to believe the worst under any circumstance. I don't look for quick fixes, but I am patient and open to maturing through the process. I live intentionally with the understanding that I will not live forever on the earth and that all my material possessions, knowledge, gifts etc. will pass away. But my acts of love will last forever in the lives, hearts and minds of those I was given the opportunity to touch while I was here. I recognize that every encounter or interaction is an opportunity for me to share God's love and make a difference in someone's life.



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
