

SHOWERING THE MONTH

with prayer



'Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain; so the LORD shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field.' Zechariah 10:1 KJV

Welcome to a new month full of possibilities. We have the opportunity at the start of every month to shape what our experience will be for the rest of the days of the month. Sometimes we start a month strong and taper off somewhere around the middle and start trying to pick up again towards the end.

Zechariah 10:1 above tells us that the Lord will give showers of rain to every one grass of the field. From this we know God is both willing and able to water the month so we function in total purpose and productivity every day of the month. The first step is asking Him for the rain and that one of the keys to activating the watering is through prayer. What makes the difference isn't just the activity of prayer, but the content.

This series we are going to explore how to intentionally design every day with specific and targeted prayer so that every day is not only watered, but fruitful, generating results that evidence the hand of God in our lives.



Day 1

Connecting in Prayer

“Then I will pour out a spirit of grace and prayer on the family of David and on the people of Jerusalem...” Zechariah 12:10

“As soon as I pray, you answer me; you encourage me by giving me strength.” Psalms 138:3

“Once Jesus was in a certain place praying. As he finished, one of his disciples came to him and said, “Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples.”” Luke 11:1

If we see prayer as an option, we won't engage in it unless we feel we have exhausted all other options. But Jesus made it clear to us that Prayer is not an option, rather it is a spiritual discipline that **MUST** be cultivated. The reason we pray also determines if, when and why we pray. If the objective of prayer is for things, then it becomes transactional. However, if we see prayer as connecting to God then it becomes transformational.

Prayer isn't just activity, it's a spiritual engagement that produces supernatural outcomes, and the Holy Spirit gives grace for prayer. Whenever we feel we're getting “dry” in the place of prayer, one of the fastest ways to revive our prayer life is to ask the Holy Spirit to pour the spirit of prayer on us.

Prayer: Lord thank You for the grace to pray through this month. I ask for a fresh outpouring of the spirit of prayer upon my life every morning this month. I thank You that my altar is on fire everyday. Holy Spirit I ask for fresh grace, fresh fire every day of the month. I ask that You show me the value of prayer so I make it a priority. Lord teach me to pray so my prayer generates tangible results throughout this month. Remove anything in or around me that will take my heart away from you and hinder my prayer. Grant me the grace to remain fervent in prayer throughout this month. Thank You in advance for all You are set to do in my life this month.

Day 2

Intentional Alignment with Purpose

“You have not chosen Me, but I have chosen you and I have appointed and placed and purposefully planted you, so that you would go and bear fruit and keep on bearing, and that your fruit will remain and be lasting, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name [as My representative] He may give to you.” John 15:16 AMP

“I knew you before I formed you in your mother’s womb. Before you were born I set you apart and appointed you as my prophet to the nations.” Jeremiah 1:5

“For we are God’s masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.” Ephesians 2:10

Every single person on this side of eternity was born pre-appointed and pre-equipped to fulfil God’s agenda. The Bible gives us an insight into how God works through His discourse with Jeremiah and just like Jeremiah, our assignment was already prepared long before we were born. Jesus made it even clearer to His disciples showing just how intentional God is about us. Not only do we have assignments, when we’re aligned with God He positions and purposefully plants us in specific areas, batons, families, etc so we can function there as His representatives.

“[I always pray] that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may grant you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation [that gives you a deep and personal and intimate insight] into the true knowledge of Him [for we know the Father through the Son].” Ephesians 1:17 AMP

However, it’s difficult to represent someone effectively if we don’t know who they are, what they are like and what they expect from us. Which means the key to truly walking in purpose lies in knowing the Lord.

Prayer: Lord I thank You for being so intentional about me. You have appointed and equipped me with all I need to fulfil my role as Your representative. Grant me the spirit of wisdom and revelation that gives me a deep and personal and intimate insight into the true knowledge of You and who I am in You so I can walk everyday in alignment with all You’ve already planned for me.



Day 3

Spiritual Climate Control

“And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins, in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience,” Ephesians 2:1-2

“Satan, who is the god of this world, has blinded the minds of those who don’t believe. They are unable to see the glorious light of the Good News. They don’t understand this message about the glory of Christ, who is the exact likeness of God.” 2 Corinthians 4:4

When Adam fell, Satan took over legal authority as the ruler of this world and he and his kingdom exert their influence on a daily basis. This is why the world consistently gets darker and evil abounds. However as believers, we have power over this influence through the price Jesus paid for us on the cross. This is why we must intentionally and deliberately control the spiritual climate over the areas that concern us and things around our lives.

“I won’t speak with you much longer, for the ruler of this dark world is coming. But he has no power over me, for he has nothing to use against me.” John 14:30 TPT

“Put on your new nature, created to be like God—truly righteous and holy.” Ephesians 4:24

“Instead, clothe yourself with the presence of the Lord Jesus Christ. And don’t let yourself think about ways to indulge your evil desires.” Romans 13:14

“And all who have been united with Christ in baptism have put on Christ, like putting on new clothes.” Galatians 3:27

For us to successfully create a different spiritual climate, we must first ensure we’re not displaying the character of the enemy. Rather we put on Christ first by yielding to the transformation the Holy Spirit works in us and then declaring the change we want to see.

Declaration: I break the control of the prince of the power of the air over my life and I bring everything around me under the influence of the Holy Ghost. I declare the peace of the Lord upon every location I go to. I declare the grace of God enables and empowers me throughout this day. The angels of God go into operation on my behalf and every crooked path becomes a highway. I fulfil God’s assignment for my life today with ease and precision.



Day 4

The Favour Factor

“Jesus grew in wisdom and in stature and in favor with God and all the people.”
Luke 2:52

“... And Esther obtained favor in the sight of all who saw her.” Esther 2:15

“Now God had brought Daniel into the favor and goodwill of the chief of the eunuchs.”
Daniel 1:9

“Awake, north wind! Rise up, south wind! Blow on my garden and spread its fragrance all around. Come into your garden, my love; taste its finest fruits.” Song of Songs 4:16

Jesus demonstrated three things concerning favour. First is that it's spiritual and comes from God, so there's no need to go around scheming or politicking as we can't engineer favour by ourselves. Second is that when we have favour with God, people will also favour us. This means that rather than pursue the applause of people, if we want to carry an atmosphere of favour our priority should be to please God first. Third is that there are increasing measures of favour. The fact that Jesus grew means we can also grow and experience more favour with each passing day.

“May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing to you, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer.” Psalms 19:14

“Never let loyalty and kindness leave you! Tie them around your neck as a reminder. Write them deep within your heart. Then you will find favor with both God and people, and you will earn a good reputation.” Proverbs 3:3-4

There's a lifestyle that births favour with God and that's a lifestyle of consistently honouring Him in our hearts, words and actions. The honour we give God shows up in the way we treat those around us. Beyond that, when God favours us, there's a fragrance we carry that makes us the recipients of favour, whether the people around us like us or not.

Prayer: Lord help me to live in a way that always pleases You. Help me increase daily in wisdom, stature and favour with You and people. Let everyone who sees or hears of me favour me. Let my aroma be that of a person who is blessed and highly favoured. Let the policies in my industry, nation favour me. Let people go out of their way to help me because my life is pleasing to You.

Day 5

Open Doors

“I will give him the key to the house of David—the highest position in the royal court. When he opens doors, no one will be able to close them; when he closes doors, no one will be able to open them.” Isaiah 22:22

“... See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it...” Revelation 3:8

Doors are one of the access routes God has given to govern our promotion. Doors speak of opportunities which are designed to be a platform for our lifting. In practical experience we won't see a physical door opening, rather what will happen is that we will encounter certain people who will act as agents of transformation in our lives. This is because people are the keys to doors: people can either provide or hinder access to opportunities.

“...I am here to tell you that you and your family are the focus of all Israel's hopes.” 1 Samuel 9:20

“When you leave me today, you will see two men beside Rachel's tomb at Zelzah...When you get to the oak of Tabor, you will see three men coming toward you who are on their way to worship God at Bethel... When you arrive at Gibeah of God... you will meet a band of prophets...” 1 Samuel 10:2-3, 5

Saul met Samuel on the suggestion of his servant while they were looking for his father's donkeys. This seemingly random meeting (from Saul's perspective) was a turning point in Saul's life on his journey to becoming king. Beyond Samuel, Saul also encountered three sets of people, with each set having a specific role to play in his life. Had Samuel not given Saul insight, he may likely have just walked past these people, not knowing there was a connection. Most of us meet people everyday and have existing relationships. However, it's possible that like Saul we're so fixed on an objective that we don't see what God has put in the people around us for us.

Prayer: Lord open my eyes to see the people You've connected me to by the eyes of the Holy Spirit. Grant me the sensitivity to see the doors You have opened for me and the people You've assigned to me as the keys to those doors.

Day 6

Dealing with Hindrances

“For a great and effective door has opened to me, and there are many adversaries.”
1 Corinthians 16:9

“We wanted very much to come to you, and I, Paul, tried again and again, but Satan prevented us.” 1 Thessalonians 2:18

“Then this Daniel distinguished himself... and the king gave thought to setting him over the whole realm. So the governors and satraps sought to find some charge against Daniel concerning the kingdom...” Daniel 6:3-4

Every time God opens a door for us, the enemy is waiting in the wings to bring a hindrance because expansion for God’s people means loss of territory for the kingdom of darkness. This is why Paul recognised that there are adversaries attached to opportunities. The key to our success lies in standing firm on what God’s promised us, knowing that He’s faithful to bring it to pass if we don’t give up.

“Indeed they shall surely assemble, but not because of Me. Whoever assembles against you shall fall for your sake.” Isaiah 54:15

“No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue which rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, And their righteousness is from Me,” Says the Lord.” Isaiah 54:17

“Stretch out Your hand from above; Rescue me and deliver me out of great waters, From the hand of foreigners, Whose mouth speaks lying words, And whose right hand is a right hand of falsehood.” Psalms 144:7-8

“But you belong to God, my dear children. You have already won a victory over those people, because the Spirit who lives in you is greater than the spirit who lives in the world.”
1 John 4:4

In addition to standing on God’s word, discernment is required so we don’t unduly expose ourselves as the enemy will work through people. Regardless we shouldn’t be afraid of the gatherings or the weapons formed. Regardless of the opposition’s activities we have the assurance that we’re on the winning side and have the upper hand.

Prayer: Lord I stand on Your promise for my life and declare that no weapon formed against me will prosper and every tongue rising in judgement against me is condemned. I decree that all those who assemble against me shall fall for my sake. I discern and am delivered from those who speak lying words and pretend to be aligned with me. Thank You for dealing with the adversaries to the doors You’ve opened for me this month. I walk in victory everyday this month.



Day 7

Walking Along the Best Pathway

“For we are His workmanship [His own master work, a work of art], created in Christ Jesus [reborn from above—spiritually transformed, renewed, ready to be used] for good works, which God prepared [for us] beforehand [taking paths which He set], so that we would walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us].” Ephesians 2:10
AMP

“So we have not stopped praying for you since we first heard about you. We ask God to give you complete knowledge of his will and to give you spiritual wisdom and understanding. Then the way you live will always honor and please the Lord, and your lives will produce every kind of good fruit. All the while, you will grow as you learn to know God better and better.” Colossians 1:9-10

“The Lord says, “I will guide you along the best pathway for your life. I will advise you and watch over you.” Psalms 32:8

God is a being of order and structure. Therefore it only stands to reason that there is an order and structure to His plan for every day in every area. Following God’s pathway is important for many reasons. One is that the gifting He has put in us can only be fully and sustainably maximised in the area(s) He has prearranged for us, so this is where we will be most fulfilled. Second is the people assigned to support us are located along His path for us, thus we will work hard, but not toil. Third is that because we are walking in divine alignment His representatives, we have the confidence of supernatural backing which will yield supernatural results. Fourth is that we don’t open ourselves up to manipulation by the enemy through comparison with others because we know whatever God is doing in the lives of others doesn’t in any way diminish what He will do in our lives.

Prayer: Lord align me to the pathways You have prearranged and made ready for my life everyday. Help me to discern Your will and the assignment for each day. Let my steps connect with those you’ve assigned to me daily and let me also be a helper to others. As I walk along Your set paths let the gifts You’ve put in me generate supernatural results and let the combination of the character of Christ displayed in me and my results shine my light such that nations are drawn to You.

Day 8

The Right Networks

“These are the numbers of armed warriors who joined David at Hebron. They were all eager to see David become king instead of Saul, just as the Lord had promised.” 1 Chronicles 12:23

“From the half-tribe of Manasseh west of the Jordan, 18,000 men were designated by name to help David become king.” 1 Chronicles 12:31

“also 220 of the temple servants, whom David and the leaders had set apart [with their descendants] for the service of the Levites. They were all designated by name.” Ezra 8:20 AMP

“One day as these men were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, “Appoint Barnabas and Saul for the special work to which I have called them.”” Acts of the Apostles 13:2

God didn't design us to do everything by ourselves. When we look through the Bible we see that people who did something significant had support from two sets of people. People who opened specific doors for the person and those who ensured the work was done. For us to be effective this month and beyond we need both sets of people to be active in our lives. We know that God is very intentional therefore we can rest assured that He has not only prearranged the work we should do (Eph 2:10), but also those who should support us on the journey. Heaven has already assigned these people to us by name. The key thing is for us to discern them and their connection to our assignments per season.

Prayer: Lord surround me with those who are eager to see me succeed. Let everyone You've specifically assigned to me rise up on my behalf and champion my cause according to Your plan. Network me to the people You've predesigned to act as catalysts for my next level. As I build capacity send me people filled with insight and understanding so I can delegate effectively as You enlarge my territory

Day 9

Spirit Filled Days

“And the Spirit of the Lord will rest on him— the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord.” Isaiah 11:2

“This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God’s Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ.” Ephesians 4:13

“And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.” Luke 2:52

The Bible tells us the Jesus increased in wisdom and stature which suggests that He must have increased in other areas also. As Jesus is the pattern we’re to follow, this should encourage us that we can also increase in the measure of the Holy Spirit that we function in. And as we increase, we look more like Jesus in character and function like Him in power in every area of our lives.

Prayer: Lord help me to increase daily in wisdom and understanding. Let my actions be undergirded by Your wisdom and let my mind be opened to function with supernatural understanding of whatever I’m faced with today. Let my ears be opened to receive Your counsel and give me a heart that is tender to Your instructions so I’m always at the right place at the right time, doing the right things and getting the right results. Let me walk in greater levels of the spirit of might every day so I remain productive at high levels. Help me grow deeper in my knowledge of who You are and who I am in You. Let the spirit of the Lord dwell in my heart in greater measure daily so all I do is motivated by a desire to honour and please You in all ways. Help me yield daily to the teaching and pruning of the Holy Spirit so I consistently increase in the measure of the standard of Christ that I walk in.

Day 10

Placing a demand on Enlargement and Expansion

““Now, as you can see, the Lord has kept me alive and well as he promised for all these forty-five years since Moses made this promise—even while Israel wandered in the wilderness. Today I am eighty-five years old. I am as strong now as I was when Moses sent me on that journey, and I can still travel and fight as well as I could then. So give me the hill country that the Lord promised me. You will remember that as scouts we found the descendants of Anak living there in great, walled towns. But if the Lord is with me, I will drive them out of the land, just as the Lord said.””
Joshua 14:10-12

“One day a petition was presented by the daughters of Zelophehad—Mahlah, Noah, Hoglah, Milcah, and Tirzah. Their father, Zelophehad, was a descendant of Hephher son of Gilead, son of Makir, son of Manasseh, son of Joseph. Why should the name of our father disappear from his clan just because he had no sons? Give us property along with the rest of our relatives.” And the Lord replied to Moses, “The claim of the daughters of Zelophehad is legitimate. You must give them a grant of land along with their father’s relatives. Assign them the property that would have been given to their father.” Numbers 27:1, 4, 6-7

“And Jabez called on the God of Israel saying, “Oh, that You would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory, that Your hand would be with me, and that You would keep me from evil, that I may not cause pain!” So God granted him what he requested.”
I Chronicles 4:10

Property in biblical days was a big deal as it signalled not just security, wealth and prominence, but also the opportunity for trans-generational inheritance. One of the things we may notice is that there was always some form of engagement required to take on additional territory. Looking at Caleb, the daughters of Zelophehad and Jabez we see a running theme: they each had to place a demand to take possession of their land. Caleb literally had to fight for his, the daughters of Zelophehad had to meet certain criteria and Jabez cried out to the Lord.

In each scenario they were successful in their objective which tells us that had they not taken any steps, nothing would have happened even though there was an opportunity for them to enlarge. They would have remained in the same place not because God wasn’t willing for them to expand, but because they simply didn’t place a demand. Even if the expansion will take time, it starts with taking the critical step of placing a demand.

Prayer: Lord bless me indeed and enlarge my territory, let Your hand would be with me and keep me from evil, that I may not cause pain. Give me the boldness to place the right demand at the right time to the right people. Give me insight into the strategy for enlargement and equip me with the right skillset. Give me the tenacity to stay focused and not lose hope, and the discipline to stand on Your word until it is manifested in my life.



Day 11

Shining as Light

“Arise, Jerusalem! Let your light shine for all to see. For the glory of the Lord rises to shine on you. Darkness as black as night covers all the nations of the earth, but the glory of the Lord rises and appears over you. All nations will come to your light; mighty kings will come to see your radiance.” Isaiah 60:1-3

“...You’re here to be light, bringing out the God-colors in the world. God is not a secret to be kept. We’re going public with this, as public as a city on a hill. If I make you light-bearers, you don’t think I’m going to hide you under a bucket, do you? I’m putting you on a light stand. Now that I’ve put you there on a hilltop, on a light stand—shine! Keep open house; be generous with your lives. By opening up to others, you’ll prompt people to open up with God, this generous Father in heaven.” Matthew 5:14-16 MSG

“For once you were full of darkness, but now you have light from the Lord. So live as people of light!” Ephesians 5:8

Jesus gave us a mandate to shine as light in a world that is not only dark, but getting progressively darker. When the Lord spoke through Isaiah about shining our light, He acknowledged that the light would shine in the midst of darkness. So darkness doesn’t surprisingly the Lord and we’re still to fulfil our mandate to shine regardless of the darkness. We can do this because we’ve received light from the Lord through the Holy Spirit.

Jesus goes further to say that He’s putting us on a stand to shine this light for the purpose of pointing people back to Him. When we understand that whatever lifting we receive is meant to point people back to Jesus it’ll shape how we interact with the people we encounter on our journey. It also keeps us mindful that we will encounter challenges because the darkness in the world is not going away. If anything the darkness acts as a backdrop for our light to shine even brighter everyday.

Prayer: Lord I recognise that there is darkness all around me and I receive the grace to shine in the midst of the darkness. Help me become intentional about shining brightly everywhere I show up today and everyday. Let every aspect of my life be a platform to showcase Your glory

Day 12

Being a Solution Provider

“There is a man in your kingdom who has within him the spirit of the holy gods. During Nebuchadnezzar’s reign, this man was found to have insight, understanding, and wisdom like that of the gods. Your predecessor, the king—your predecessor King Nebuchadnezzar—made him chief over all the magicians, enchanters, astrologers, and fortune-tellers of Babylon. This man Daniel, whom the king named Belteshazzar, has exceptional ability and is filled with divine knowledge and understanding. He can interpret dreams, explain riddles, and solve difficult problems. Call for Daniel, and he will tell you what the writing means.” Daniel 5:11-12

“Joseph’s suggestions were well received by Pharaoh and his officials. So Pharaoh asked his officials, “Can we find anyone else like this man so obviously filled with the spirit of God?” Genesis 41:37-38

“Therefore, please command that cedars from Lebanon be cut for me. Let my men work alongside yours, and I will pay your men whatever wages you ask. As you know, there is no one among us who can cut timber like you Sidonians!” 1 Kings 5:6

“But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you know all things.” 1 John 2:20

There are needs and challenges everywhere and people all around us are seeking solutions. The Bible tells us those who carry the Holy Spirit have a unique ability to solve problems because the One we carry within us knows ALL things. If we have a relationship with the Holy Spirit, we automatically have access to the wisdom that’s beyond what any human can comprehend. It was the Holy Spirit at work in Daniel and Joseph that singled them out in their careers.

Likewise, wherever we function, we should be sought out as solution providers - the ones called upon to bring the answer to challenging situations. While we must make every effort to build the necessary skill and capacity, the solutions we provide won’t always be due to our natural skill or intelligence alone but the access we have to the wisdom of the One who knows all things. Let’s tap into this so that throughout this month and beyond as we are sought out as solution providers.

Prayer: Lord I ask for the wisdom for every challenge I encounter to be revealed to me. Open my mind to receive, understand and communicate the solution. Help me become a consistent solution provider everywhere You place me so my life and track record of results showcases Your wisdom and points people back to You.



Day 13

Power and Wisdom

“But to those called by God to salvation, both Jews and Gentiles, Christ is the power of God and the wisdom of God.” 1 Corinthians 1:24

“And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.” Luke 2:52

“Then Jesus, being filled with the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness... Then Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to Galilee, and news of Him went out through all the surrounding region.” Luke 4:1, 14

Jesus embodies the fullness of God’s wisdom and His power. When we go through the life of Jesus while on Earth, we see that He went through a season of processing by the power of the Holy Spirit, during which He increased in both wisdom and power. Which reveals to us that there are greater measures of both available to us as we commit to walking and working with the Holy Spirit.

Jesus had a lifestyle of consistent prayer, time in the word as well as seasons of fasting and the results of these were seen clearly in His life. His life is a lesson to us about who and what we can be if we allow the Holy Spirit to take the lead in our lives and submit to His guidance.

“God’s purpose in all this was to use the church to display his wisdom in its rich variety to all the unseen rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.” Ephesians 3:10

“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” Acts 1:8

God’s purposed wasn’t for Jesus alone to demonstrate His wisdom and power but for all His children who make up His body (the church) to actively demonstrate these in every situation and region so that we act as His witnesses - people who can testify to the reality of God, His power, wisdom, sovereignty and love.

Prayer: Lord help me pay the price to increase in the demonstration of Your power and wisdom. Let my daily life manifest the life of Jesus, let my daily experience be that of showcasing Your glory, power and wisdom at all times and all situations.



Day 14

Living Worry Free

“Lord, you alone are my inheritance, my cup of blessing. You guard all that is mine.” Psalms 16:5

“God’s way is perfect. All the Lord’s promises prove true. He is a shield for all who look to him for protection. For who is God except the Lord? Who but our God is a solid rock? God arms me with strength, and he makes my way perfect.” Psalms 18:30-32

“See, I have written your name on the palms of my hands. Always in my mind is a picture of Jerusalem’s walls in ruins.” Isaiah 49:16

In the days we’re in worry is something that can take over our lives if we’re not careful. There always seems to be something negative happening because bad news travels faster than good news. In our own lives we also have a tendency to focus on what isn’t happening or hasn’t happened rather than all that we already have going for us. It’s easy for issues to become magnified if that’s what captures our primary focus. Meanwhile Jesus said we shouldn’t worry. Not because there won’t be things to worry about, but because He’s promised to Never leave or forsake us. Which means even in the middle of the challenge He’s there with us walking us through it.

“Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.” Psalms 23:4

“So be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid and do not panic before them. For the Lord your God will personally go ahead of you. He will neither fail you nor abandon you.” Deuteronomy 31:6

“...For God has said, “I will never fail you. I will never abandon you.”” Hebrews 13:5

Transferring our worries to God relieves us of the pressure of trying to figure everything out in our own. Our confidence shouldn’t be in ourselves or the things around us, but in the One who’s promised never to fail or abandon us.

Prayer: Lord You said You will never fail or abandon me. You said to drop all my worries at Your feet because You’re always thinking about me and only You have the capacity to deal with every issue I may face. You said You guard all that is mine and contend with those that contend with me. My times are in Your hands and You alone have the final say. So I will not worry or fear because You are in charge.



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
